The roles and responsibilities of the Audit and Risk Committee and consequently its members are clearly outlined in the Audit and Risk Committee Charter and are in line with the provisions of Chapter 3 of the Treasury Regulations and King III Report. The Audit and Risk Committee will meet at least four times a year.

REQUIREMENTS: Three year post matric qualification or higher. Expertise in Information Technology, Accounting, Auditing, Financial and Risk Management. Skills, competence and experience in serving on Audit Committees of Government Departments, Public Entities. Sound knowledge of the principles of Corporate Governance.

Knowledge and understanding of the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) and Treasury Regulations and other relevant legislation/policies, e.g. GRAP, GAAP, National Treasury Instructions and Practice Notes. Knowledge and understanding of the roles of Internal and External Auditors. Exposure and knowledge of Councils/ Boards and how they operate. Understanding the Cultural Institutions Act.
